The invitation is open to all those who wish to present scientific papers and contributions (which are related to theories, methods, solutions and results of the applied research) and that can contribute to a further knowledge of the state of the art and to open new developmental perspectives regarding relations, communications or poster forms based on the following themes:

WILL, FREEDOM AND NECESSITY FOR THE CREATION OF THE LANDSCAPE-CULTURAL MOSAIC

As far as any ideas regarding papers or posters are concerned, the illustrative report on the conference held by Prof. Livio C. Piccinini, Head of the University of Udine’s Superior School, has been enclosed for your information. The interdisciplinary sessions which will be discussed at the conference are the following:

International impact:

The safeguard of the landscape in the countries under transformation: can one attain the post-modern world without having to pay the price for a modern one?

Plenary sessions: contributions regarding the followings topics:

1. Beauty as a guide for the landscape mosaic order
2. Tensions and resolutions within the urban landscape
3. Biodiversity as an element for the necessary evolution of landscape
4. Rural and urban construction in its historical evolution between freedom and necessity
5. Necessary and possible transformations for landscape-cultural order
6. Eco-tourism as a form of freedom in order to rediscover ancient networks
7. The shared will in the management of bio-cultural landscape

8. The reorganisation of urban fragmentation within the cultural framework
9. Necessity as a balancing element between will and freedom
10. The organization of the free offer towards the integrated tourism industry
11. Typicalness as a form of freedom and its conditioning within preservation
12. Fragile goods and their reconstruction: falsification or fetishism
13. Methods of critical evaluation of the politics of landscape-cultural order

Interdisciplinary sessions. Ideas for papers or posters are listed in the following sessions:

- I A The programmed discussion: its evaluation, its acceptance and its perception
- II B Beauty and freedom of creation: the limits of conventions and transgression
- II C Evolution of landscape-cultural systems: endogenous and external factors
- II D The hetero-direct freedom and the creation of new requirements: the guided exploitation
- III E Conceptual nets as a factor of order and legibility of the landscape-cultural mosaic
- III F The continuous creation of landscape and the recovery of the past
- IV G The order within the mosaic: parks and theme areas
- IV H The use of artistic, cultural and natural goods as an act of freedom

DEADLINE: contributions in the form of summaries (for a maximum of 2,000 characters), must be forwarded in word or rtf format by August 15th, 2007 and EXCLUSIVELY by e -mail to ipsapa@libero.it ABSTRACTS AND CONTRIBUTIONS WHICH ARE SENT ELSEWHERE ARE INVALID. Participants will be informed by August 31st, 2007 whether their contributions have been accepted. You are kindly requested to inform the pre-selected interdisciplinary session for the presentations. Only those contributions which are enclosed with the attached and completed registration conference forms will be taken into consideration. The scientific committee reserves the right to decide the presentation format. The reception area of the conference will provide participants with the summaries and the CDs regarding the reports. Participants must send the provisional versions of their work (a maximum 15,000 words - for posters - and 25,000 words for reports and communications) by September 30th, 2007 to ipsapa@libero.it.

The definitive version of the work must be sent exclusively to iseppi@uniud.it by December 20th, 2007 according to the guidelines established for publication purposes.

The conference documents will be published by the IPSAPA / IPSALEM on one special CD issue in the “International Interdisciplinary Agri-Business Landscape & Environment” magazine (Agribusiness Landscape & Environment Management) or in the “Landscape Architecture” magazine. The “Agri-Business Landscape & Environment” magazine reserves the right to select some contributions to publish in a paper format in an issue of the same magazine. This will be in agreement with editorial views as established by the Advisory Board which is presided by the President of the Scientific Committee of the same magazine, Prof. Piero Susmel, or in a special collection volume for the exploitation of the Agribusiness Landscape and Environment resources which is directed by Prof. Augusto Marinelli. In this case, the text must be compiled following the rules for contributors to the AP&A magazine.

There is no fee for attending the conference
